| | | <p>The applicant then advised that a smoking shelter would be constructed at the the side entrance and smokers would have to stay in that confined area. No smoking would be allowed on the road and only four persons would be allowed in the smoking area and that she was trying to work with neighbouring parties.</p> <p>Simon Jones then referred the Committee to Appendix D of the report that illustrated the layout of the proposed Smoking Shelter.</p> <p>The applicant then gave details of how the smoking area had been blocked off and that customers would not be able to walk up the steps due to the fence.
