116	Application for a Permit to place Tables and Chairs on the Public Highway - New Crown Inn, 28 High Street, Merthyr Tydfil	<p><u>In attendance:</u> Mr Jorge D'Ascencao (the Applicant).</p> <p>Amy Gould, the Council's Licensing Officer, led the Committee through the report in respect of an application for a permit to place tables and chairs on the public highway at the new Crown Inn.</p> <p>Amy Gould advised that, since the publication of the agenda, the Police had agreed to an amendment to the conditions, namely that teas and coffees could be served in crockery in the designated area.</p>

		<p>PC Kelvin Jones made representations in respect of this application and advised the Committee that South Wales Police do not oppose the application, but request that additional conditions be added.</p> <p>Mr D'Ascencao then addressed the Committee and outlined that one member of his staff would solely supervise this area along with the beer garden at the rear of the premises and understood that Challenge 21 would still apply in the outside area.</p> <p>Questions were raised by the Committee and were answered by the appropriate officers.</p> <p>The Chair then thanked all parties for their attendance and they left the meeting.</p> <p>The Committee then considered the application, and it was:</p> <p>RESOLVED that:</p> <p>The application to place tables and chairs on the public highways outside of the new Crown Inn be agreed and that the conditions, as stipulated in the notice of determination, be implemented.</p>
