A consultation letter drop was carried out to residents in the vicinity of the Galon Uchaf Road Toucan crossing in October 2015. In accordance with Statutory procedures, public notice was given of the County Borough Council's intention to establish a Toucan Crossing and included a Notice advertised in the Merthyr Express on 24th December 2015 stating that objections to the Notice should be returned by 15th January 2016. Public Notices were also displayed on site.

(ii) Give details of how you have engaged with service users on the proposals and steps to avoid any disproportionate impact on a protected group and how you have used any feedback to influence your decision.

Consultation and engagement has been carried out with Penydre High School. A consultation letter drop was carried out to residents in the vicinity of the Galon Uchaf Road Toucan crossing in October 2015.
