Code of Conduct for Members and Co-opted Members: Request for Dispensation - Councillor Chris Davies

1.0 SUMMARY OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 To consider an application from Councillor Chris Davies who seeks dispensation to speak and vote on matters relating to the Flying Start Programme and Early Years and Child Care matters as he is the Chairman of Plant Bach Pre School Setting Committee. This also applies to any pursuant "interest" that may be deemed to arise thereunto, relating in any business conducted by the Authority or any of its Committees which comes before the Council, Cabinet or any of its Committees.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION(S)

- 2.1 The Committee is requested, in light of the facts presented in the report contained within the application, whether or not it is prepared to exercise its discretion under any of the sub sections of Regulation 2 of the Standards Committee (Grant of Dispensation) (Wales) Regulations 2001 to grant the Councillor seeking dispensation an entitlement to speak and vote at any meeting (where appropriate).
