ANNEX 1 - MANDATORY CONDITIONS
Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -
- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Licensing Act 2003 (Mandatory licensing conditions) (Amendment) order 2014

- 1.-(1) The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
- (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises-
- (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group

defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;

- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
- (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

2. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

3. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
- (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a either-
- a) A holographic mark, or
 - b) An ultraviolet feature

4. The responsible person must ensure that:-

- (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:-
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
- (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
- (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1-
 - a) 'duty' is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
 - b) 'permitted price' is the price found by applying the formula-

$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

Where -

- i. P is the permitted price,
 - ii. D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
 - iii. V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- c) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence-
 - i. the holder of the premises licence,
 - ii. the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - iii. the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
 - d) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
 - e) 'valued added tax' means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
 4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

Mandatory condition where at specified times one or more individuals may be at the premises to carry out a security activity:

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed-

- (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c.12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
- (b) in respect of premises in relation to-
 - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
 - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).

(3) For the purposes of this section-

- (a) "security activity" means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
- (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

Mandatory condition: exhibition of films

- (1) Where a premises licence authorises the exhibition of films, the licence must include a condition requiring the admission of children to the exhibition of any film to be restricted in accordance with this section.
- (2) Where the film classification body is specified in the licence, unless subsection (3)(b) applies,
- (3) Where-
 - (a) the film classification body is not specified in the licence, or
 - (b) the relevant licensing authority has notified the holder of the licence that this subsection applies to the film in question, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that licensing authority.

(4) In this section-

"children" means persons aged under 18; and

"film classification body" means the person or persons designated as the authority under section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 (s. 39) (authority to determine suitability of video works for classification).

ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

A suitable colour CCTV system shall be installed at the premises providing DVD recording equipment with a monitor out of reach of the public. The CCTV system shall have coverage of all areas to which the public have access including all entrances and exits, excluding the toilet areas.

The system shall be capable of providing 31 days of 24 hour recording and images shall be retained for 31 days and produced as soon as practicable at the request of South Wales Police or other enforcement authorities at no extra cost to those agencies.

A Police Architectural Liason Officer shall approve the system.

here will be no off sales of alcohol and no alcohol is to be consumed immediately outside or in the close proximity to the club.

A personal licence holder must be present to authorise and supervise the sale of alcohol when the premises is open to the public.

All measures shall be taken to minimise noise when regulated entertainment is taking place at the club.

The club should implement and operate a 'Challenge 21 Scheme' as promoted by Local Authority Trading Standards Officers which will include -

The display of appropriate warning signs to the effect that any persons appearing to be under 21 will be subject to challenge in respect of age restricted goods.

All persons appearing to be under 21 will be required to produce an acceptable form of ID namely

- a) Passport
- b) Photo driving licence
- c) Pass accredited proof of age

The bar area and any alcohol sales will always be supervised by a club committee member.

Checks on any person who looks under 18 years old will be made by the bar staff.

We will display leaflets within the premises advertising the fact that we will challenge anyone who appears to look under 18 years old

If anyone is found to be underage, we will log the date of the event and their details into a refusals log, which will be kept on site for review by the police or trading standards.

We will review the information pack being sent and note any further actions we will need to ensure we comply with all of the requirements placed upon us.

The female toilet accommodation to be increased to provide 3 WC's

No musical entertainment to be allowed outside the premises

The use of the external loudspeakers and floodlighting around the pitch to be restricted so that they are not used between 8pm and 8am in connection with any entertainment activity or to facilitate any activity by patrons of such activity

The patio doors to the function room must remain closed during all musical entertainment and the doors must be sealed fully when in use for this purpose to prevent any airgaps

The patio doors must not be employed as fire doors, an alternative safe fire exit route must be employed. If the patio doors were used as fire escapes their air seal would be compromised in terms of noise protection.

The front external doors or an internal door to the club area must be kept closed during musical entertainment so as to avoid the excessive escape of noise from the premises.

The small air brick in the external wall of the function room must be effectually sealed so as to minimize noise escapes.

ANNEX 3 - CONDITIONS ATTACHED AFTER A HEARING BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY

1. That the external area as defined on the site plan be restricted in order that it extends no further than a parallel line 4 metres from the front wall of the premises.
2. That the external area as defined in 1 above shall be enclosed by way of a fence or dwarf wall which should be no less than 1 metre in height.
3. That the external area as defined in 1 above shall be for the use of club members only.
4. That the area as defined in 1 above shall be for the consumption of alcohol but not the sale of alcohol.
5. (a) Between the 1st March and the 30th September the area as defined in 1 above shall not be used for the consumption of alcohol after 9pm each night of the week.

(b) Between the 1st October and the last day of February the area as defined in 1 above shall not be used for the consumption of alcohol after 6pm each night of the week
6. All licensed doormen employed or used by the club must be SIA registered.
7. That licensed doormen must be in attendance at the club when the area defined in 1 above is in use.
8. That customers drinking in the area as defined in 1 above shall use only polycarbonate glasses.
