Progress against Priority for Improvement Objective	Definition	Measure Guide
Very good progress	The delivery of the Business Improvement Plan is having a very good impact and the priority for improvement objective has been addressed in all respects. No aspects require further attention. The local authority's capacity to maintain and build on this improvement is very good	Almost 100%
Strong progress	The delivery of the Business Improvement Plan is having a positive impact and the priority for improvement objective has been addressed in most respects with only minor aspects requiring attention. Most aspects have been covered already and there is little significant work left to do. The local authority's capacity to maintain and build on this improvement is good.	90% or more
Satisfactory progress	The delivery of the Business Improvement Plan is not yet having a strong enough impact. The priority for improvement objective has been addressed in many respects but there is still significant work to do in important areas.	70% upto 90%
Limited progress	The delivery of the Business Improvement Plan is having little or no discernible positive impact on the priority for improvement objective. All or many important aspects are still to be addressed and there remains much work to do. The local authority is not yet demonstrating strongly enough the capacity to secure the necessary improvement.	< 70%

Nearly all - with very few exceptions

Most - 90% or more

Many - 70% or more

A majority - over 60%

Half- 50%

Around half - close to 50%

A minority - below 40%

Few- below 20%

Very few - less than 10%

Fully Met	The delivery of the Business Improvement Plan has fully met the priority for improvement objective. No aspects of the objective require further attention.	100%
Substantially Met	The delivery of the Business Improvement Plan has met the priority for improvement objective in most areas with only minor aspects requiring attention. Many aspects have been covered already and there is little significant work left to do.	70% or more
Partially Met	The delivery of the Business Improvement Plan has met the priority for improvement objective in around half to a majority of areas but there is still significant work to do in important areas.	40% upto 70%
Not Met Sufficiently	The delivery of the Business Improvement Plan has met the priority for improvement objective in only a minority of areas with many important aspects still to be addressed.	< 40%
