## **PETITION RECEIVED BY THE AUTHORITY**

### **1.0 SUMMARY OF THE REPORT**

- 1.1 To advise Council of a petition received by the Authority relating to speed humps on Twynyrodyn Hill and the works undertaken by the Highways Department to resolve the difficulties experienced by residents.

### **2.0 INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 A petition was received by the authority on Tuesday 4 February 2020 expressing concerns about the speed humps on Twynyrodyn Hill, specifically the one opposite Newton Terrace.
- 2.2 The petition requested that the authority put a ramp on the speed hump to prevent damage to vehicles that repeatedly use the road.
- 2.3 The petition contained approximately 185 signatures and was forwarded to the Chief Officer for Neighbourhood Services for attention.

### **3.0 RESOLUTIONS**

- 3.1 In response to the petition, the Highways Department arranged for remedial works to reprofile the speed hump opposite Newton Terrace to improve the ride quality.
- 3.2 The works were due to take place week ending 14 February 2020, but due to forecast inclement weather the work was brought forward to Thursday 6 February 2020.
