Re : Licensing act 2003

Application for Premises Licence at premises known as Clwb Crown, Webster house, Dynevor Steet, Merthyr Tydfil CF48 1BA

I have reviewed the application and I am of the opinion that the application does not promote the licensing objective of “prevention of public nuisance” and therefore **I am objecting to this application.**

I specifically have concerns around the potential nuisance from noise from activities proposed within the application namely live music, recorded music and noise from patrons.

I note that the application contains standard hours for,

- Live music to be 9am – 1am (7 days a week)
- Recorded music and recorded music 9am – 2am (7days a week)
- Premises open to the public from 6am to 2:30am (7 days a week).

In addition to the above hours the application seeks to apply for non-standard timings of an additional hour on Christmas eve, Boxing night, New Year’s Eve, New Year’s day and Sundays preceding bank holidays.

The application also includes significant external areas with little information on how noise will be controlled.

I note that in order to promote the licensing objective of prevention of public nuisance the application only includes the following statement:

“Staff will proactively encourage customers to leave quietly and digital signage will be used to encourage good behaviour”. In addition to this I note the application states that “Roof top terrace cleared & closed by 10:30pm”.

There are residential areas in close proximity to the premises which are likely to be impacted by noise should this application be approved, and I reiterate that I object to this application because in my opinion the application does not promote the prevention of public nuisance.
