Second strategy for Wales ,updated end of last year

Intention of Strategy – the elimination of VAWDASV in Wales

Has six key objectives –Will be delivered through a blueprint governance structure .

Set out its aspirations for public sector bodies and their partners

Strategy is based on 6 underlying principals

This strategy has a broader focus than previously so has more policy linkages and more cross boundary working with other strategic partnerships.

- CTM is developing a suite of documents in relation to its strategy
- The strategy, a delivery plan and a risk management plan
- Strategy is complete
- Delivery plan is in development and risk plan not yet started
- Statutory duty to develop and publish a local VAWDASV strategy
- Our local strategy objectives mirrors the National Strategy with the addition of local data and information



VAWDASV services – Cwm Taf Morgannwg

- In CTM we are developing and delivering separate and distinct support services for :-
- Adult victims of VAWDASV
- Perpetrators of VAWDASV
- Children and Young People- who have experienced domestic abuse
- Separate provisions are required for each of the above groups across the three elements of VAWDASV
- Aiming to create consistency of provision across the region
- In addition we have to provide awareness raising activity, preventative services education activity



What Services does Merthyr Tydfil have for VAWDASV ?



- Victims – Refuge, DA tenancy support, DART IDVA and Outreach service, recovery programmes, IRIS, Court IDVA ,Remote evidence suite ,MARAC, DA and substance misuse service, Family intervention programme, ISVA ,sexual violence counselling and recovery programmes
- Perpetrators – Drive, Driving change, Family intervention programme,
- CYP- Comets and Rockets, CYP IDVA,ISVA, sexual violence counselling and recovery
- Merthyr Tydfil also have access to the VAWDASV Regional Adviser

How are services funded in Merthyr Tydfil?



Services are funded primarily through grants

Grants include VAWDASV revenue , VAWDASV capital, PCCO ,HSG , Charities and trusts, APB,MOJ

Some services are funded through a combination of grants pooled together

None of the services provided through grants are sustainable or secure.
